

DECLARATION ON EXEMPTION CONCERNING REACH

1. The Regulation 1907/ 2006/ EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), does not apply to gelatin and collagen as they are natural polymers. The amino acids are considered as non-isolated intermediates and therefore do not have to be registered.


The criteria explanation for the exemption of natural polymers are explained in the ECHA guidance on polymers.

The exemption for registration of gelatin and collagen and their monomeric units has been confirmed by ECHA and by the German REACH helpdesk.

2. Gelatin and collagen are not classified hazardous following the European Directive 67/548/EC and Regulation 1272/2008/EC.
